# DAY 1: ARRIVE WASHINGTON, D.C.

# **DAY 3: WILLIAMSBURG - PARADE**

Then explore Colonial Williamsburg's Historic Trades such as Apothecary, Blacksmith, and Silversmith. # **DAY 4: YORKTOWN - WILLIAMSBURG**

Today visit nearby Yorktown, where British

commander Lord Cornwallis surrendered to Washington's troops in 1781. Visit the American Revolution Museum at Yorktown which tells the story of the nation's founding. Exciting indoor galleries feature period artifacts, immersive environments and films including "The Siege of Yorktown." Outdoors explore a re-created Continental Army encampment and a 1780's farm with costumed interpreters re-enacting daily life.
